He boldly proclaims, *As for me and my household, we will serve the Lord*. In St. John's Gospel, many disciples cannot accept Jesus' teaching on the everlasting gift of His Body and Blood. Christ asks the Apostles if they, too, wish to leave Him and return to *their former way of life*. Simon-Peter professes that Jesus has the *words of eternal life*; where else would they go? Serving the Lord as His disciple is challenging. St. Paul, in his Letter to the Ephesians, likens Christ's relationship with the Church to the marital relationship between husband and wife. Following Christ's will has a definite cost, but He assures us of His strength to accept that cost."
