- ◆ Courtesy of the Diocese of Springfield...some thoughts during this Jubilee Year of Mercy - September 11, 2016 - **“Lost sheep. Lost coin. Lost child.** Losing a possession is one thing. Losing one's way is something else. Today's examples: (1) The people of Exodus so lost their way to God, they turned to a molten calf of their own design. Worshiping something that is not God is idolatry, is deep down infidelity, is mistrust of God. Moses pleads for these stiff-necked people. And God relents; God does not punish. (2) The prodigal son thought owning things and going far off was the way to live. He comes to his senses and returns home and finds his father - filled with compassion - running to embrace him. The point: it is God's very nature to relent, to exude compassion, to run to us, to love. *How can I be like God today? *For whom will I plead today? *Whom will I run to embrace?”
