**House Bill 2467 & Senate Bill 1594**
  - *Repeals* Illinois Parental Notification of Abortion Act. This *current law* requires a parent or legal guardian be notified when a minor seeks an abortion.**House Bill 2495 & Senate Bill 1942**
  - *Repeals* the current state ban on partial-birth abortions.
  - *Defines* abortion as a fundamental right.
  - *Removes* abortion clinics from regulations for serious medical procedures.
