- Word of Life – “There is such a wide spectrum of issues involving the protection of human life and the promotion of human dignity. Good people of frequently disagree on which problems to address, which policies to adopt and how best to apply them. - Stewardship – January 21, 2024 – Third Sunday of Ordinary Time – (Compliments of the Archdiocese of St. Louis, MO) - “*Follow me and I will make you fishers of men.*” - *Mark 1:17* Jesus’ call to “*follow me*” is a call to all Christians! The call is in the here and now, in our present circumstances, not when we think we are “ready” or have everything in order. Good stewardship of our God-given gifts means that things aren’t always going to go according to our schedule, but that God has a much better plan in store for each of us.”
