It is a traveling food pantry that delivers nutritious food (meat, produce and nonperishable items) to people in need. The Mobile Food Pantry uses a "drive thru" method to distribute pre-packed groceries. Participants do not need to be Catholic. Catholic Charities, Diocese of Joliet helps people of all faiths and beliefs.
