If you would like to help with the project, traffic volunteers are asked to arrive by 2:30 p.m. and volunteers to assist in packing boxes by 3:00 p.m. All are asked to wear closed toe shoes. The Pantry goes on...rain or shine from 4:00 - 5:30 p.m., or until the food runs out. It is a traveling food pantry that delivers nutritious food (meat, produce and nonperishable items) to people in need. The Mobile Food Pantry uses a “drive thru” method to distribute pre-packed groceries. Participants do not need to be Catholic. Catholic Charities, Diocese of Joliet helps people of all faiths and beliefs.
