Volunteers...assist clients with organizing, reviewing, and paying bills, help prepare checks for signature and assist with balancing client’s checkbook and visit clients in their homes. A Money Management Volunteer is...knowledgeable about budgeting, is able to assist clients with paying bills, is a great communicator, enjoys working with older adults, attends quarterly training, must pass a background check and is available to volunteer a minimum of 8 hours per month.
