- Christ’s Passover - Immaculate Conception Parish of Braidwood is hosting Christ’s Passover this Lenten season on Wednesday, April 5, 2023 at 6:30 pm in the parish hall. We will explore the connection between the Jewish Passover meal and the Last Supper that Jesus shared with His Apostles, and how it relates to Mass and the Holy Eucharist today. Bible readings from both the Old and New Testaments form the foundation of this event, with emphasis placed on Jesus’s Last Supper to His crucifixion. This free event includes a sampling of food items shared at the Last Supper with an explanation of the symbolism of each. Sub sandwiches will be served afterwards. The public is invited to attend and participate in this free event.
