Guardian Angel Outreach is a ministry established in 2007 by St. Michael the Archangel Parish of Streator. This ministry assists mothers and their infants from conception until the child turns three years old. Families earn points to receive diapers, wipes, and other baby supplies a baby may need through the first years of life. Points are earned by reading articles on parenting concerns, reading books to the child, referring a friend, taking the child to doctor appointments, and similar additional opportunities. Guardian Angel Outreach is located on the third floor of OSF Center for Health (old hospital) at 111 Spring Street, Streator, and is open Tuesdays and Fridays from noon to 4:00 p.m. Contact numbers are (815) 673-3966 or (815) 822-0802.
