  - **Special collection next Sunday, Sept. 12, for Haiti recovery efforts** - The people of Haiti have suffered greatly in recent days, as both an earthquake and tropical storm have struck the country located in the Caribbean Sea. Numerous lives have been lost, and many Church properties, along with homes and businesses, have been severely damaged or destroyed. Catholic Relief Services is on the ground providing humanitarian aid, and the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops' Subcommittee on the Church in Latin America has approved \$10,000 grants to each of the three most affected dioceses. But more help is needed. In his role as USCCB president, Archbishop Gomez of the Archdiocese of Los Angeles has called for a voluntary, special collection to support the USCCB Bishops Emergency Disaster Fund to provide additional aid to Haiti. The Diocese of Joliet has set the weekend of Sept. 11-12 for this special collection.
  - CCD will begin **next Sunday Sept. 12<sup>th</sup>** – CCD will be held from 9-10 a.m. on Sunday mornings – at this time, masks will be optional. Registration will be available before and after church on the first day. Fees are: \$40.00 for first child / \$60.00 for two or more. An additional fee of \$25.00 will be assessed for those who will be celebrating the Sacraments of First Communion or Confirmation.   - Just a reminder...During the month of September, Fr. Stan will be returning to Poland to visit family and friends. Upon his return, he will be attending Priest Convocation.
