September, 2017 Report from St. Mary's Finance Committee: The Finance Committee met in June and finalized our 2018 budget which began on July 1, 2017. The committee meets several times a year with Father Stanley and Lin Hopwood to carefully monitor St. Mary's income and expenses. As of June 30, 2017 our parish had a total overall deficit of \$2,721.85. As you are aware utility and insurance costs continue to rise and our church income must as well. Last year utilities for our building and our 20% of the rectory were \$4,300.50. The October 8 "Maintenance Collection", along with one other "Maintenance Collection" during the spring will help toward our expenditures. A fundraising project was also discussed as a possibility at our meeting. We are asking each of our parishioners to donate as generously as possible to the two Maintenance Collections since this money is designated entirely for the care and maintenance of St. Mary's of Reddick. Thank you for your support; it is the reason our church continues to be an important fixture in our community.
