Ecclesiastes 1:2; 2:21-23. Psalm 90:3-4, 5-6, 12-13, 14, 17. Colossians 3:1-5, 9-11. Luke 12:13-21.

About being greedy. Every day, it seems, we are faced with two dilemmas: what we want and what we need. Our grasping for wants, our desire to amass more things, more money, more prestige, etc. can eat us up. Ecclesiastes declares the hunger for property is a mere wisp, a puff of wind, a vanity. Jesus is more direct: guard against all greed. What we need, really, are the things of God. And in grasping the things of God, we grasp onto God – and thereby are rich.

- What do I want? Make a list.
- In checking that list, what do I need? Really need?
- Check the Corporal Works of Mercy. How can I give up some of my wants to give to someone in need?
