Twenty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time – 21 August 2022 Isaiah 66:18-21. Psalm 117:1, 2. Hebrews 12:5-7, 11-13. Luke 13:22-30. Are Only a Few to Be Saved? It is not uncommon for someone to ask us: "Have you been saved?" Often, they are looking for one fixed date, one specific event. But we know these truths. (1) We are saved everyday - because of God's grace. (2) God chooses to save everyone - me and them. (3) Salvation is strengthened by working for justice, by living merciful lives.

- How will I acknowledge that I am being saved by Christ every day.
- How will I cherish that everyone is saved even those people I do not like but need to still love?
- What mercy work does this summon me to do this week?
