My Pledge for Lent:

Engaging Your Family in the Celebration of Lent

The season of Lent begins with Ash Wednesday on March 6th. On March 3rd, your children will be bringing home a Rice Bowl for your family. During the time of Lent, discuss opportunities for kindness, giving, and selflessness. At the bottom of this page, you can help your child create a pledge for Lent. Here are some ideas to help your children contribute to the Rice Bowl:

- Act of Kindness Challenge: create a jar for each family member filled with ideas of acts of kindness. Daily, pull out an act to complete for the day. Each time that act is completed, add a coin to the Rice Bowl.
- Coins for Caring: Each time you see your child complete a caring act for a family member or friend, give them a coin to add to the Rice Bowl
- Help your child give up a treat, such a ice cream or candy. Add the money you would have spent on the treat to the Rice Bowl.

Stations of the Cross will be held each Wednesday evening. This is a great opportunity for our children to learn about the journey that Christ endured for us.
