Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary – Saturday, 08 December 2018

God comes to favor us. From the beginning days in Eden, the man was assured by God not to hide. Clothing helped. From the beginning new days, God's angel tells Mary: Do not fear – God favors you – the Spirit will do holy things in you – nothing is impossible! How can this be? By God's grace and mercy.
