June dedicated to Jesus-Mary introduces Sacred Heart. May, Mary's month, is followed by the month dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Thus it should be-Mary leads us to Jesus. That is her role. If in the month of May we give special thoughts to our Blessed Mother, then it will not be difficult to turn our thoughts to the Sacred Heart in June. For devotion to Mary-if it is true-if it does her honor-if it is pleasing to her-will not stop her. In the Gospel Mary's role is clearly indicated. She is mentioned only a few times, and then only in her relation to her Son. At Bethlehem, she "brought forth her first born" and presented Him to the Shepherds and to the Magi. At Cana, at the wedding feast, she introduced Him to the public. On Calvary, she suffered with Him and she offered with Him. At Mary's side, we shall learn what it means to love the Sacred Heart of her Divine Son.
